## AUTISM FRIENDLY PERFORMANCES



On the way in, patrons may have to wait in line.

There will be people helping with security to make sure everyone is safe.

An usher will scan each ticket (on a phone) so patrons may enter the theatre.

TDF Volunteers will be passing out different fidget tools.



There are many seats in the theatre!



I will show my electronic ticket to the usher to seat me. The numbers on the ticket let me know where my specific seat is.





Inside the theatre, an usher will let everyone know where to go.

I may use the bathroom on the way to my seat or at any time during the show.

All bathrooms are family bathrooms. Anyone may use any bathroom and caretakers may provide personal assistance as required.





The theatre will become dark and quiet so the audience can experience the sounds of the show- the singers and the live orchestra.

The actors wear costumes when performing. This helps them pretend to be the characters they are portraying.



Actors will not touch anyone in the audience.



If the show is ever too loud or too bright, a Break Area are available.

In this areas, there are bean bag chairs and mats to sit or lay on.

When ready, patrons may go back into the theatre to experience the show!



There will NOT be an intermission, a break during the show.



The audience may clap during and at the end of the show. Clapping lets the actors know that the audience likes their performance.

If the clapping is too loud, TDF volunteers have ear plugs and noise canceling headphones to help make it quieter.







When the performance has finished, the audience will  
leave the theatre.
